The KRIS Rosé, a blend of several red wine grapes from the Veneto region, is a refreshingly crisp wine to enjoy on its own, pair with patio dinners or elevate every day moments.

Tasting Notes

The Kris Rosé is of light elegant pink color with shiny reflections. It surprises with aromas which remind of delicate hints of peach, strawberries and summer fruits.

Labels

The timeless and inspiring KRIS label emphasizes the role of the sun in ripening the grapes to perfection, the human hand in crafting the wine and the lips savoring the wine. Each label was designed by the contemporary Italian artist Riccardo Schweizer (1925-2004).
